



Boarding Fees & Services

Effective August 22, 2011

All boarders must participate in a lesson program and may be billed if desired. All board includes hay, blanketing, and grain. Supplements are extra and must be provided. We suggest Smart Pak or Blue Ridge Distribution.

Full Training [monthly, see *Training Programs ~ Lesson & Show Fees*] – Add to board 550.

Boarding

Boarders who pay their bills by the 5th of the month receive a \$50 discount.

Upper Barn

12x14, Nelson waterers, ComfortStall floor, 2 days/wk Horse Gym, night hay at bedcheck 950.

12x14, matted stall floor, night hay at bedcheck 850.

Arena Stall [12x12, rubber mat floor] 750.

Arena Stall Share [12x12, rubber mat floor] 650.

Pasture Board 500.

Co-op @ the Riding Academy: HP provides stall and hay. Boarder provides feed, labor, shavings. 400.

Single Arena Stall [10x10 temporary, per day, if available] 35.

Horse Gym Sessions

Full Training Clients 2/week [\$15 per session] 125.

Weekly Lesson Clients 2/week [\$20 per session] 175.

Individual Sessions 35.

Full Groom

Horse fully groomed 4 times per week and kept “show prep” ready 175.

Horse tacked for owner [by appointment] 20.

Hauling by Thaxtons**

Fifty cents/per mile, per client plus fuel, loaded or not

Minimum hauling per horse [multiple – single] 50. -- 75.

Wrapping, loading/unloading [horse loads in 10 minutes or less] 10.

Loading/unloading packed equipment without owner assistance 10.

Handling**

Hourly fee with horse for veterinarian, farrier, or illness 15.

Recovery/Medical Care**

Prepare and administer medications or wrap legs, per occurrence 5.

Therapy/treatments [based on handling fee], maximum per month 500.

Clipping**

Full body clip [pony – horse] 125. - 150.

Partial body clip [no legs clipped] 75.

Show trim [ears, bridle path, muzzle, coronet band, fetlocks] 35.

Show Preparation

Pull mane or bathe, per occurrence 30.

Braid mane for dressage 45.

Horse Rental

Use of horse, when not in a lesson [per day] 50.

Maintenance & Finance Fees

Annual cost of farrier, teeth floating, deworming and vaccinations are averaged into a monthly fee and disbursed by HPF, Inc on your behalf. This fee is adjusted up or down as appropriate. Varies

Checks returned for insufficient funds. 50.

** Prices do not include veterinarian expenses should horse require tranquilizers. Nor do they reflect handler’s fees, should horse require the aid of others.
